

MANUAL

General

The LumiTour app contains a list of your collected accommodation spots (already booked or interesting), information about day trips, restaurants and cafés, route details, and other personal Points Of Interest (POIs).

You can add these POIs yourself, or import them from a friend or from an organization (for example, a B&B/hotel where you are staying). Importing is done by scanning a QR code with your camera or by opening a shared web link.

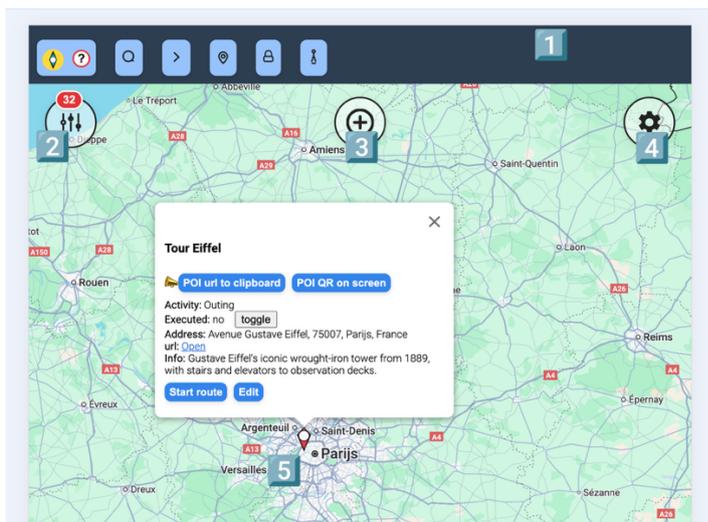
There are 3 types of POIs that remain separated within the application: your own, those received from a friend, and those from an organization.

POIs belong to categories (Accommodation, Food & Drink, Route, Activity, Other).

In LumiTour you can easily see the information you have collected (or received) that is nearby. By using filters, you can quickly find what you're looking for, such as *“Which nice excursions are available in my area?”* or *“Where are the locations where we already booked accommodations?”*

The App

When you start the app, you see the **map screen**, with your current location as the center.



The Buttons

At the top of the app you'll see a toolbar with several buttons.

1 MAP Navigator – navigate within the map.

Below this, when starting the app, you see a Google Maps screen with 3 buttons at the top:

2 Filter, **3 POI Management**, **4 App Settings**.

- **Filter button:** lets you filter which POIs are shown on the Google map; for example, all booked accommodations.
- **POI Management button:** lets you add new POIs (manually or by import), and also share your POIs. You can share as a *friend* or as an *organization*.
 - POIs shared as an organization are temporarily visible to the recipient and cannot be modified.
 - When sharing, you receive a QR code on screen (which you can also print via the print button), or you can share the link by email or social media.
 - With the “delete selection” option you can remove the currently selected POI.
- **App Settings button:** gives access to general settings (your name, app language) but also allows you to export your database to CSV, delete all POIs, or create and restore backups of your app data.

Prevents your phone from going into standby while this page is active



Live Tracking

Follows your live location on the map and automatically centers it.

👉 Tip: enable *Wakelock* to prevent your phone from going into standby.

Usage

On the map you see the POIs stored in the app. Combined with the filters you apply, you see exactly the POIs you want.

Looking for your booked accommodations? Tick these, and the map shows all the places where you will be staying during your trip. Still in the process of booking? Add optional places so you can easily find them again (also on the map) and revisit them quickly via the link.

When you click on a POI on the Google map , the details of that POI appear. Depending on the content, several buttons may be available:

- Share POI via on-screen QR (as friend)
- Open route planner to the location
- Edit the POI

Thus, the LumiTour app becomes the central place where all your trip information is stored. And at your destination, you can add interesting info from your host into the app, and easily search for excursions or restaurants in the area.
